The 'Catty Sark' leaves Sandhaven Harbour. A revolutionary design, but not a greatly successful fishing boat.



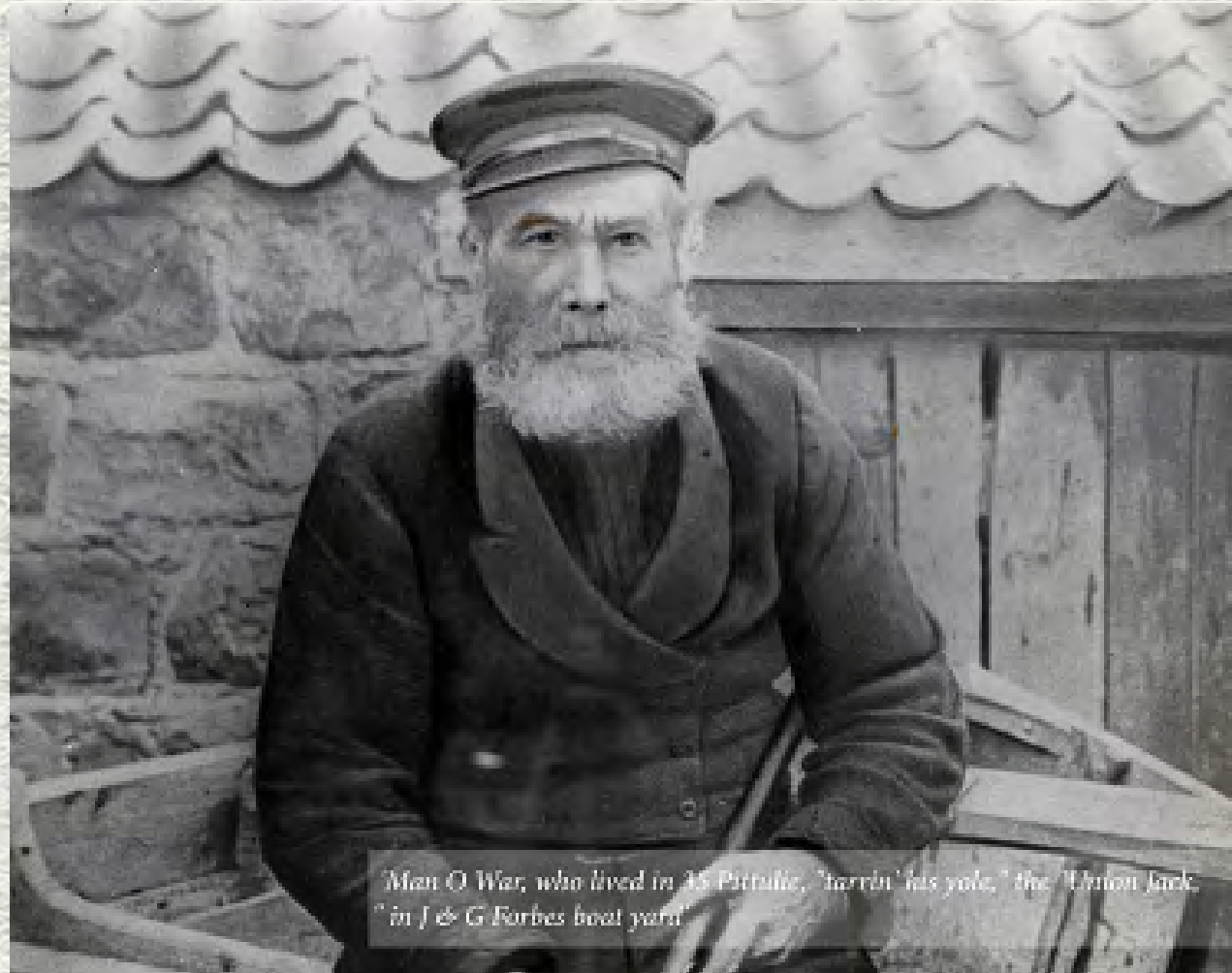

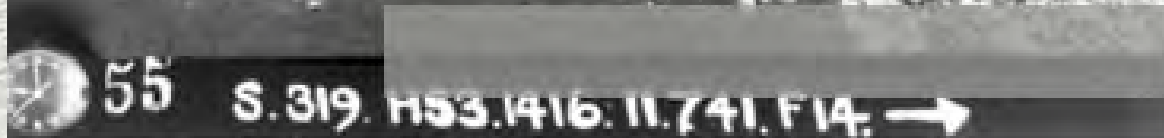

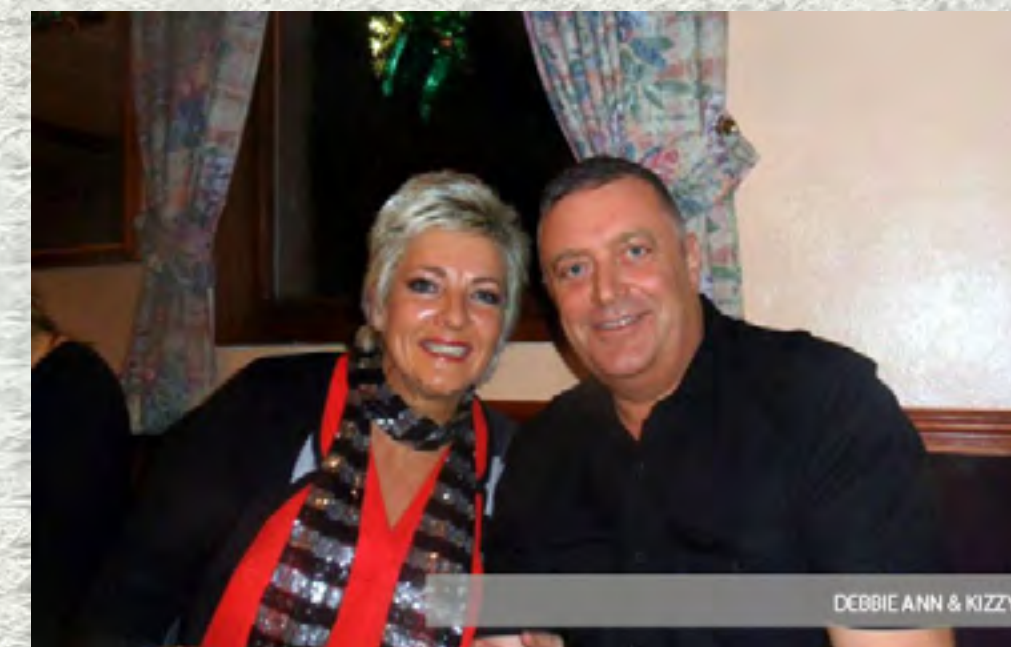
